WELCOME, CILE MITCHELL!

Bishop B. Michael Watson has appointed The Reverend Cecile (Cile) Mitchell to be our new associate pastor. We are delighted to receive her, and look forward to her ministry in our midst.

Cile, a single parent with 3 adult daughters and one grandchild, was educated here in Middle Georgia, attending school in Jones County and graduating from Miller High here in Macon. She has an undergraduate degree from Georgia Southern, a master's degree in education from Valdosta State, and a degree in Administration from the University of Georgia.

Much of Cile's life has been spent in education. Her thirty years in that field include teaching special education and disability learning. Since 1979 she worked in Jones County, where for the last 15 years of her career she was curriculum director, technology director and pre-kindergarten director.

While teaching Disciple Bible Study at the Gray United Methodist Church Cile began to understand that God had a deeper, more specialized call in her life. She enrolled at the Candler School of Theology and graduated last month with her master's of divinity degree. Last week in Savannah Cile was commissioned for service in the church by Bishop Watson and admitted to Probationary Membership in the South Georgia Annual Conference.

For the past few years Cile has been worshiping at the Park Memorial UMC on Arkwright Road where she served as an intern under Sam Lamback's leadership. She comes to us now for her very first appointment, which means that you and I have the privilege of shaping and influencing Cile in many positive ways, even as she will do the same for us.

Cile's many responsibilities will include evangelism, missions, education, older adult visitation, hospital visitation, pastoral care, worship leader, and much more. I am eager for you to meet Cile and to experience her warm personality and dedication to ministry. We'll have a lemonade reception in our parlor immediately following the 11 a.m. service so you can greet her. Welcome, Cile!
